Safety Tips for Kids and Youth Fundraising

Whether they want to sell candy, wash cars, or ask you to sponsor them to do their homework or chores here are some safety tips to keep in mind while they get creative fundraising for NYEP.

- Please make sure that your kids understand that they need your permission before they start any fundraising.
- We recommend that any kids or youth that are involved in fundraising are supervised by a responsible adult.
- We recommend that kids or youth that are involved in fundraising do not approach strangers to ask them to participate in their fundraising efforts.
- Please be careful when publishing any information about kids or youth, specifically their surname, school name, address, phone number, or photo.
- Always check with other parents before you involve any other kids or youth in fundraising, especially if any information about the event is being photographed or filmed.
- We recommend that a responsible adult looks after the money that is being collected. We don't recommend that kids or youth hold on to the money, pay us the money or their personal information directly.
