If you are fundraising for Nevada Youth Empowerment Project, please keep it fun, safe and legal- take a moment to read some do's and don'ts before your start:

- Please make sure that all of your fundraising materials (fliers, posters, etc.) state that your fundraiser is "in support of Nevada Youth Empowerment Project (NYEP) a registered charity EIN # 261118584.
- Please make sure that your fundraising materials do not suggest that you represent NYEP, only that you are fundraising in support of us.
- If you are a business or individual and you will be fundraising for us by selling services or goods or running an event or promotion where you will be deducting costs or expenses from your fundraising you may want to inquire with us about getting a Fundraising Agreement. - While it is common for people to fund raise door to door, this is not always a safe practice and we don't recommend it. Phone calls, email and social networking is the preferred method of contact.
- If children (under the age of 16) are involved in fundraising in any way, please make sure that they have permission from their parent or guardian and are properly supervised by a responsible adult. Children and youth should never approach strangers about fundraising. If you are fundraising with kids or youth, please take a moment to read our [Fundraising Safety Tips for Kids and Young People](#).
- If you are planning any type of lottery or raffle, please be aware that there may be some rules and regulations in the State or Nevada about what you can do. You can learn more [here](#).
- You should always consider whether you need appropriate insurance to cover your fundraising activity. If necessary, carry an at-risk assessment and make sure that all participants are fully briefed about the activity.
- Do your research. There are lots of websites like www.betterfundraising.com that have ideas, tips and tools that will help to get you started.
- Do HAVE FUN!!! We want to get to know you and for you to get to know us. Although, we love raising fund for our organization, most of all we want all of our supporter to have fun and stay safe!!
